

WHAT'S NEW IN LARC REIMBURSEMENT?

An emergency rule change was approved on December 30, 2021 to clarify that reimbursement for Long-Acting Reversible Contraceptives (LARC) will be paid outside of the Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC) encounter rate for Medicaid Members.

Health Centers may now bill the device, procedure code, and the encounter rate when providing LARC. Health Center's will bill on a HCFA 1500 with the device and procedure codes along with the T1015.

If your Health Center is a 340B provider carved-in with Oklahoma then the Drug Rebate Department will bill your Health Center back for the drug rebate portion quarterly per OHCA 340B Drug Rebate Policies. Please reach out to the drugrebateunit@okhca.org for any 340B related questions.
